

When her family had grown she began to discover the frustration of sewing patterns not fitting well any more. Clothing in stores, too, wasn't fitting well. For the last fourteen years, she has travelled North America learning from many sewing teachers. Her most difficult task was researching exactly what happens to women's bodies as they mature and understanding how the physical changes affect the fit of sewing patterns and clothing. Ron will show how to solve these problems with underlinings and how to stabilize other loosely woven fabrics and strengthen delicate ones, using lining and interfacing.

Sew in, fusible, non-woven, woven, weft, knit, and hair canvas. Everyone has been overwhelmed with all the different types and weights of interfacings on the market at one time or another. In this class find out which ones are right for your garment. Problems with puckering interfacing? Discover which manufacturers have preshrunk their interfacing and which have not.




