Supply list: 5m freezer paper (white or brown), card stock or cereal box cardboard, paper piecing pre-cut hexie shapes, if you have them, acrylic hexagon shapes if you have them, medium-large scraps in prints, stripes and solids. (Think about the colour scheme, contrast and/or theme of your samples and bring the appropriate fabric OR as this is a techniques class, bring whatever is handy). A scrap of quilt batting, minimum of 4" x 4", water-soluble 1/4" fabric glue stick, quilting needles size 11 or Sharps needles size 11, basting thread, thread to match your fabric, paper scissors and fabric scissors, thimble, rotary cutter and small mat (rotating if you have one), ringle-hole punch if you have one
